Howdy pardner:

Here is some information we hope will be helpful to you in planning your trip to St. George.

Range: We are now using our **NEW RANGE**. To get there, take exit 16 off Interstate 15 and head towards Hurricane. Go about 2.5 miles (2nd stoplight) and turn right into the Washington County Fairgrounds and Southern Utah Shooting Sports Park. Follow the road southwest (keep right) in front of the fairgrounds. Keep going on the dirt road for another ½ mile and you'll see us on the right side of the road. Maps to the range can be found on our website <http://www.dixiedesperados.com>

Lodging: If you haven't already arranged for lodging you should do so immediately. Information on lodging can be found online at www.utahsdixie.com. The Holiday Inn has rooms at a discount for Cowboy Shooters. If you're looking for a really good value in a hotel, try lodging in Hurricane, which is actually a little closer to the new range than St. George is. Dry camping is available at the range – no fee.

SCHEDULE

Thursday: Registration opens 7:30 AM
Side matches begin 9:00 AM
Side matches end 2:00 PM
Plainsman event time will be announced at the range (probably held around 2 p.m.)
Cowboy Clays 9:00 AM at the new trap/skeet range, \$5.00 extra fee

Friday: Registration opens 7:30 a.m. with 6 stages of shooting starting at 9:00 AM

Saturday: 6 stages of shooting starting at 9:00 AM

Cowboy Exchange: We will have tables and a cashier available at the range to help you sell any cowboy gear you want to part with. Make sure you tag your items with you price, name, and contact info.

Awards Ceremony & Dinner: Our awards ceremony and dinner will take place on Saturday evening (April 19) at the Holiday Inn. Directions will be in your shooters packet. We will have a social hour beginning at 6:00 pm and the dinner to follow at 7:00 pm. The dinner is included in your registration fee, but additional dinner tickets will be available at the range on Thursday for a cost of **\$25.00** and must be purchased in advance. Dinner tickets for shooters will double as door prize tickets - only registered shooters will be eligible for door prizes and you must be present to win. We will also be having our Costume Contest at the dinner so bring your fanciest cowboy/cowgirl duds and come have a great time. Guests are eligible for the costume contest.

Overall Cowboy/Cowgirl: We will be awarding a prize for the fastest overall cowboy and cowgirl of the match.

Lunch: We have arranged for vendors to provide lunch each day at the range for a reasonable price.

Long Range Single Shot	8

Friday & Saturday Main Match (12 stages total)

Average of 10 rifle, 10 pistol, and 4 shotgun per stage
